

## **RoHS and WEEE Product Compliance Policy**

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS) in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (Amendment) Regulations 2014 SI1771.

The UK regulations on WEEE identifies the measures which need to be taken for the prevention of electronic and electrical waste and producer obligations for the financing of the costs of the collection, treatment, recovery and environmentally sound disposal of WEEE.

The UK regulations on RoHS “restrict(s) the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.” In effect, new electrical and electronic equipment can contain only agreed levels of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB), and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants.

Advanced Electronics Ltd. complies with the UK regulations on WEEE and RoHS.

As a producer of WEEE our products carry our name & address and the crossed out wheelee bin logo detailed below. Our Producer Registration Number is WEE/FE0604UU.



The presence of this logo indicates that the product should not be placed in the general municipal waste and that it should be segregated for separate collection by the OEM identified on the equipment.

All Advanced Electronics Ltd control panels and peripheral items for the fire and emergency lighting market are not exempt from the WEEE directive. Separately collected WEEE product is to be sent to approved recycling or disposal operators for safe recycling, recovery or reuse.
